What the Team Expects

- This team will be run professionally, and players are expected to conduct themselves professionally. Once a member of the team, players are representing the team AND the communities!
- All players, coaches, and volunteers will be courteous to opposing players, coaches, and volunteers, as well as referees. **NO TRASH TALK, NO EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES OF ANY SORT WILL BE TOLERATED.**
- Players will respect all coaches' decisions. Dissension and back talk will not be tolerated.
- Never take personal issues and disagreements to coaches during practices and games. Coaches and the owners will be available to discuss any issues away from the team.
- Players will be expected to attend all practices. If players miss practices, regardless of talent they will be relegated to back-up roles to people whom attend every practice.
- Continually strive for improvement.
- Hustle onto and off of the field, we NEVER walk on the field.
- Never stop before the whistle. Being behind the play or away from the play never keeps you OUT of the play.
- Always be ready to enter the game or be called upon at practice. Be attentive.
- If these rules upset you (not you specifically, players in general), you're not the caliber of person we want representing the community and we are wasting your time.

What the Players Can Expect

- Players will be trained to execute the fundamentals of football.
- ALL Players will play, separate of special teams.
- Players that are not offensive or defensive starters have first choice to be special teams' starters. This does not mean they will ONLY play special teams, it gets them more field time to combine with role of backups.
- Players will never be subjected to demoralization.
